These changes reduce your risk of falling, improve general safety, increase accessibility, and improve your functional abilities.

## Our Process

1. Call or email to see if you are eligible for Safe Homes.
2. If eligible, we will conduct an over-the-phone intake conversation.
3. A licensed Occupational Therapist will call you to schedule an in-home assessment.
4. The Occupational Therapist will meet with you to discuss safety recommendations for your home.
5. Our Program Coordinator will create your job scope and set up contractors to complete your work.

## Eligibility

**To qualify Safe Homes, you must meet the following criteria:**
